REPORT ON SWACHHTA PAKHWADA

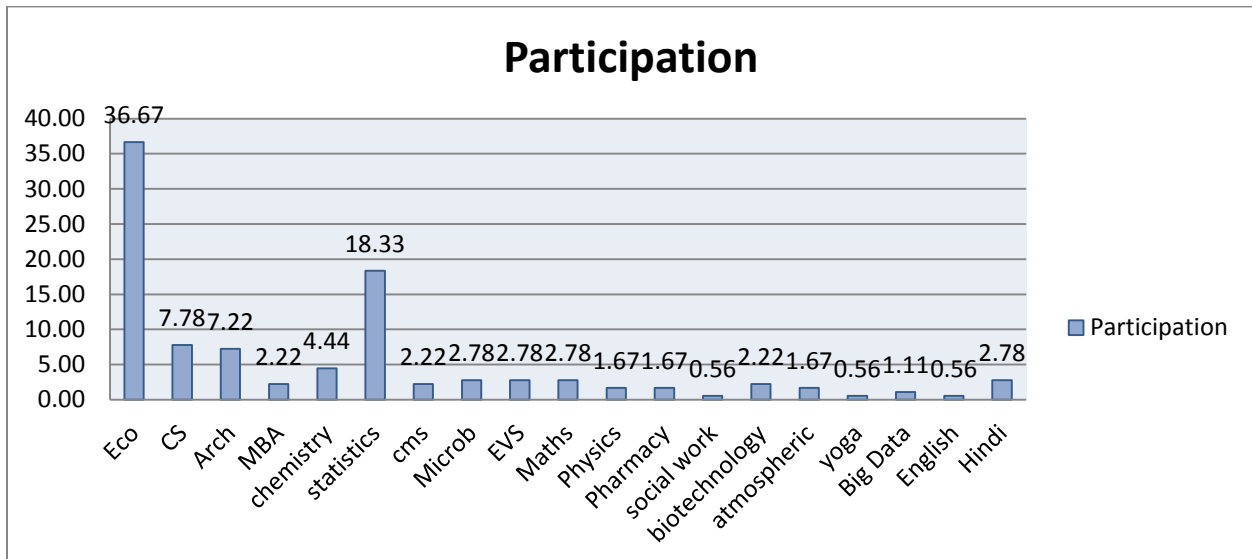
1-15 September 2017

With Reference to Letter (D.O.F. No. 1-11201 7(Secy), dated 18 Aug 2017) received from Secretary & Financial Advisor, UGC, Central University of Rajasthan organized “Swachhta Pakhwada” under the banner of NSS During 1-15 September 2017 for spreading the message of cleanliness not only among the students but also in the surrounding areas.

The objective of the camp was to spread awareness and evoke sensitivity to virtues of sanitation and Cleanliness, and help the Government in successfully achieving the initiative of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan.

Under "Swachh Bharat Abhiyan", the government has promised "total sanitation" by 2019, which means every household in India will have a toilet by the targeted deadline. So let us take a look at the contribution of CURAJIANS and NSS to achieve the mission of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan.

1. Student Participation



Total 180 students almost from all departments participated in the camp. It has been observed that students from newly established departments like Yoga have also contributed in the mission of Swachh Bharat Abhiyan. The highest participation was received from the department of Economics and Statistics during the camp. Departments like computer science and Architecture have also contributed significantly.

2. Clean Campus Day



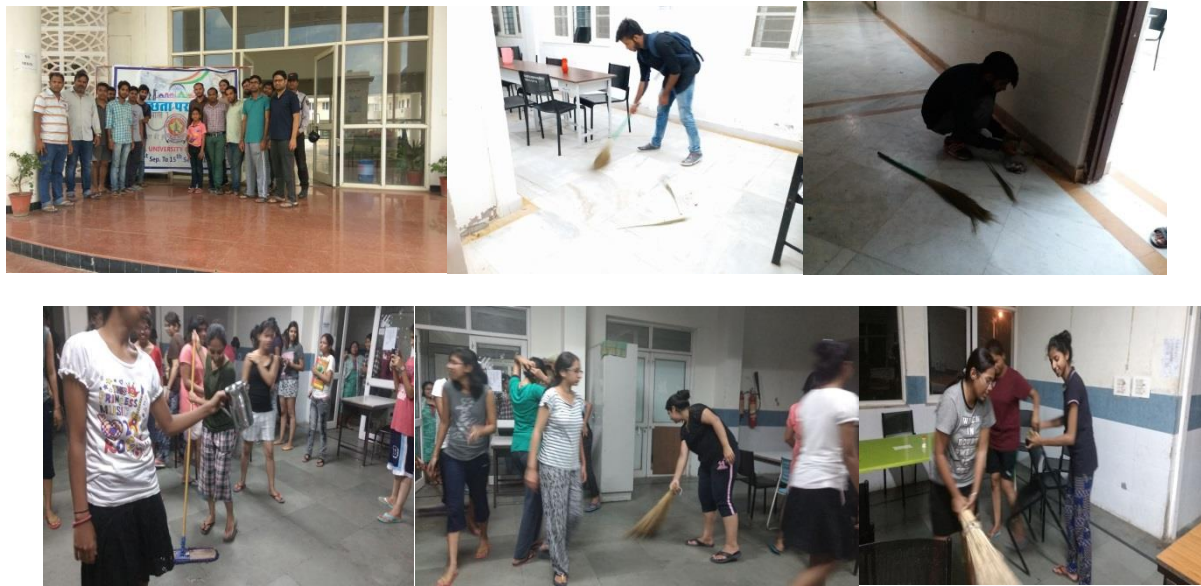
This activity was organized on the very first day on 1st September 2017. Students from Economics, Computer Science, Architecture and Physics participated and cleaned the Canteen, ground, tennis court and behind the hostel Areas.





3. Clean Hostel Day

The clean hostel day was organized on 2nd September 2017 in the hostels of B06 and B05. Students from Statistics, Social Work, Micro-biology, Economics, and Architecture have participated and cleaned the hostel corridors and reception areas.



4. Green Campus Day

The green campus day was organized on 3rd September 2017 at the new building area and entry of the main gate. Students from Economics, Statistics, Architecture and Physics participated. Various seasonal and evergreen saplings were planted by the students. The activity had aim to evoke the environmental responsibility and sensitivity in the youth.





5. Clean Mess Day

The clean mess day was organized on 4th September 2017 in the evening in the all mess of respective hostel buildings. Team of boy volunteers cleaned the building B07 and Mega-Mess. They cleaned the kitchen and dining hall areas.

Girl volunteers contributed in cleaning of mess B01, B02 and B04 and around 25 girl students participated from each hostel. The girl students cleaned the dining hall after taking food around at 10:00 PM. They deserve a huge round of applause.

We expect that the same energy and passion will sustain in not wasting the food, which would be the biggest contribution in clean mission of India.



6. Essay Writing Competition

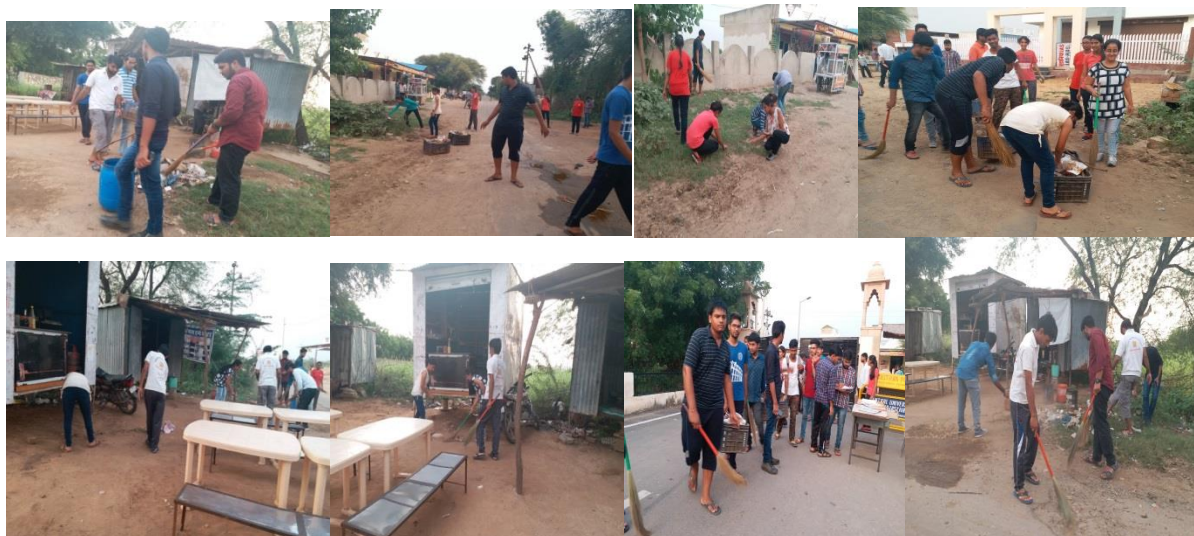
Essay writing competition was organized on 5th September 2017 on the topic “Innovative Ways for Spreading the Message of Hygiene”. Students participated from Architecture, Chemistry, Economics, Computer Science, and Physics departments. The competition was organized both in Hindi and English Languages. The topic had aimed to shuffle the young minds for the innovative

ways to achieve the targets of clean India mission; A UN report in May had said that currently, nearly 60 percent of India's population practice open defecation which puts them at risk of diseases like cholera, diarrhea, typhoid etc. And the problem of open defecation in India exists due to poor mindsets. The young mind and their innovative ways can only change the society as they are the future of India.



7. Clean Surrounding Day

Clean surrounding day activity was organized on 6th September 2017. Students from various departments' statistics, Physics, Microbiology, Chemistry, Economics, CMS, computer science, Architecture, and Physics participated. We went outside the campus and cleaned the tea stall and Pani-Puri stall areas and also the roads leading to the university.



8. Visit to Kishangarh

Our team visited public spaces in Kishangarh Tehsil on 7th September 2017 and interacted with the officers of Municipal Council about the garbage cleaning system in Kishangarh. Around 600 sweepers work every day for cleaning the 45 wards in Kishangarh. They have door to door

garbage pickup system. They have also started with scientific disposal of waste and vermicomposting technology.

9. Visit to Nearby Villages

Our team visited nearby villages Patan, Bandarsindri, Ladhera and Nohria on 8th September 2017 to spread the awareness of the hygiene and sanitation. Volunteers conducted street plays to spread this message more effectively. Volunteers surveyed 218 households in Patan Village and found that 61 households were without toilets and 13 households toilets were not in use. It was observed in field survey that cleanliness and Water supply is the major issue of this village as there is no proper drainage system. Our team also went to the village schools to create awareness among the school students about organic and inorganic wastes.





10. Visit to Nearby Market

Volunteers visited nearby market on 9th September 2017 to spread the awareness of hygiene and cleanliness.



11. Visit to Hospital

Our team visited the Government Y.N. hospital Kishangarh on 10th September 2017 to study the garbage cleaning system and management of hospital wastes. It was found that hospital dispose the waste into the big dustbins placed 5 km away from the city. We visited administrative office and interacted with officers to know the cleaning system in the hospital and also visited each and every ward. It was found that majority of wards were clean and placed with dustbins. But the general wards were bit unclean and with less number of dustbins. Their cleaning system is arranged on the contract basis.



12. Visit to Orphanage

We visited orphanage on 11th September 2017 to study the garbage cleaning system at Jai Ambey Seva Samiti Old Age orphanage located in Ajmer District. This was a great experience for all of us who visited the place. We visited each and every room including Kitchen, washrooms, corridor and garden; all areas were clean and hygienic. In every room they placed proper dustbins, and all bathrooms were clean. They support the green and clean environment. We found the people from Andhra, local city and far places like Philippines, who shared their experiences with us. The orphanage has tie-up with Mittal Hospital Ajmer for the routine check-up of its members. Management serves also good and healthy food to them.





13. Cleanest Hostel Room Contest

Cleanest Hostel Room Contest was organized on 13th September 2017 in which students of B01, B02, B04, B05 and B06 hostels participated. The assessment was based on room management, Cleanliness, resource management, Clean Walls, Books and Wardrobe management, Creativity and Innovation and Support to Green environment. We found that students are using waste in innovative ways in resource management in their rooms; they are utilizing waste papers and newspapers in their cleaning system. We found eco-friendly resources in few of the rooms.



14. Elocution Competition

Elocution competition was organized on 14th September 2017 on the topic “Health and Hygiene is the real Wealth”. Students from Economics, Hindi, Chemistry, Management and Physics departments participated. The aim of the activity was to discuss the importance of health and hygiene.
